Purpose

This Graduate Apprentice will further the goals and vision of the Division of Student Life in the area of intercultural engagement by working with students, student leaders, and programs within this area to foster belonging, and develop intercultural maturity, interfaith literacy and cooperation, build healthy community, and contribute to faith formation.

Responsibilities

- Work 20 hours each week on average as planned with supervisor; includes intermittent evening and weekend work as needed
- Serve as graduate advisor for Better Together, Baylor University's interfaith organization, coordinating the work of undergraduate Civic Interfaith Leaders (CILs)
- Coordinate and execute programs such as Neighbor Nights and initiatives related to interfaith literacy and cooperation, and civil discourse
- Invest alongside Senior Coordinator of Intercultural Engagement in the development, delivery and assessment of curriculum, trainings and workshops regarding the division's intercultural engagement model
- Meet with students one on one in a mentoring capacity as appropriate
- As appropriate, assist with and participate in special events and programs facilitated by the Division of Student Life
- Perform other duties as assigned
